ORDINANCE NO. B-292

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, NAMING EXISTING STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-101 provides that the Governing Body of any city is authorized and empowered to designate and establish, by ordinance, the name of any existing or proposed street or part thereof within the city; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Victoria, Kansas, (the "City") hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to designate and name certain streets within the corporate limits of the City;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the portion of West Main Street of the City extending from U. S. Highway 40 south to the City Ballpark shall be hereafter known as "BALLPARK ROAD".

SECTION 2. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the portion of East Main Street extending from U. S. Highway 40 south to the water reservoir of the City shall be hereafter known as "MAIN STREET TERRACE".

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption and approval and the publication hereof one time in the City's official newspaper.
