EMPLOYEE BENEFITS ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. B-312

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER B-221, EMPLOYEE BENEFITS CONTRIBUTION FUND, OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 13-14, 100.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Pursuant to K.S.A. 13-14, 100, the City of Victoria does hereby create an Employee Benefits Contribution Fund for the purpose of paying the city's share of employee benefits prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> The cost of the city's share of employee benefits authorized for payment from the fund created by benefits authorized for payment from the fund created by Section 1 of this ordinance shall include the following:

- A. Kansas Public Employees Retirement Benefits;
- B. Social Security Benefits;
- C. Workmen's Compensation Benefits:
- D. Accumulated sick leave:
- E. Unemployment benefits;
- F. Administrative Costs.

<u>Section 3.</u> Ordinance No. B-221 of the Code of the City of Victoria, and as adopted on February 11, 1985 published on March 21, 1985, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
