VACATING CITY STREET

NOW on this 23rd day of April, 1993, the matter vacating a portion of Centerline Front Street comes before the City Council for the City of Victoria, Kansas.

The location of the street to be vacated is described as follows:

That portion of Centerline Front Street which extends east of the east right-of-way line of east Main Street in the City of Victoria, Kansas, approximately 150 feet long and 100 feet wide.

After viewing the portion of said road to be vacated, members of the council unanimously agree that the road is not a public utility, by reason of neglect and nonuse and that the necessity for said road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair said road or put the same in condition for public travel.

That the Governing Body of the city of Victoria, Kansas, gave public notification of this meeting to vacate the above portion of said street pursuant to K.S.A. 12-504 and that no persons appeared to contest the Petition to Vacate a portion of said street.

Therefore, the City of Victoria, Kansas, hereby vacates the portion of Centerline Front Street described above and that such property shall revert to its original owners, his or her heirs, successors or assigns.
