## ORDINANCE NO. B-350

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION, LICENSING AND FEES FOR SHUFFLEBOARD, BILLIARD AND POOL TABLES AND COIN OPERATED MACHINES WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, ELLIS COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS CHAPTER'V, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 5-113, BUSINESS REGULATIONS, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SHUFFLEBOARD, BILLIARD AND POOL TABLES, COIN OPERATED MACHINES: Setting up and operating any shuffleboard table, billiard, pool table, video machine, or similar amusement device, the fee for each such device shall be one dollar (\$1) per table or coin operated machine, per month for the first table, and fifty cents (\$.50) per month for each additional table or machine.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Ellis County Star, the official city newspaper.
