## ORDINANCE NO. B-493

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 15-221, OF CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, AS ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 9, 1995, BY PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF WATER RATES INSIDE THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, AND BY PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF WATER RATES OUTSIDE THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 15-221, of Chapter XV, Article 2, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, as adopted on October 9, 1995, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 15-221 WATER RATES. All water sold by the City to regular customers shall be on a metered basis. The rates to be charged therefore shall be as follows:

## INSIDE CITY

- A. A minimum charge of ten dollars (\$10) for the first two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) each month.
- B. For all water in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) in any month two dollars (\$2) per one thousand gallons (1,000 gals.) in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.)

## OUTSIDE CITY

- A. A minimum charge of twenty dollars (\$20) for the first two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) each month.
- B. For all water in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) in any month four dollars (\$4) per one thousand gallons (1,000 gals.) in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.)

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 15-221, of Chapter XV, Article 2, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, as adopted on October 9, 1995, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall take effect on  $\underline{June}$  / , 2007, and after its publication in the Hays Daily News, the official city newspaper.
