AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15-105 AND 15-215 CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA BY PROVIDING FOR CONNECTION AND TRANSFER CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Sec. 15-215, of Chapter XV, Article 2 of the Code of Ordinances, as adopted on October 9, 1995, and as published on October 19, 1995, and further amended on November 20, 2000, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 15-215. Connection and Transfer Charge. Upon applying for utility services provided by the City of Victoria, the applicant shall pay a non-refundable fee of \$40.00.

If an applicant later requests to transfer utility services to another residence or business within the City, the transfer fee shall be a non-refundable fee of \$5.00.

In the event a former resident of the City applies for utility services and the former resident had a past delinquent account with the City, the former resident/applicant shall pay a non-refundable fee of \$120.00. This provision shall not be applicable if the applicant applies for services more than five (5) years after the delinquent account was incurred.

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}$. Sections 15-105 and 15-215, of Chapter XV, Article 2, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Russell County News, the official city newspaper.
